

1999 Awards And Nominations

The Mike Schneider Band was recognized as one of Wisconsin's best polka bands in 1999. In February, they were nominated for a

Wisconsin Area Music Industry (WAMI) Award in the polka category. This distinction was followed in July by a




nomination for the National Cleveland Style Polka Hall of Fame's "Best New/Young Band" Award. After having won its 1997 "Horizon Award", the Wisconsin Polka Hall of Fame also honored the Mike Schneider Band with a nomination in its 1999 "Band of the Year" category – an award for which they were also nominated in 1998.

Looking Ahead To 2000

The Mike Schneider Band is scheduled to perform in Concord, WI on Saturday, May 20^{th} for the 22^{nd} Annual Wisconsin Polkafest as

presented by the Wisconsin Polka Boosters. Mike also plans to begin working on his next album which is tentatively set to be released in the spring of 2001.
